

Toronto and Niagara Tour

4 days 3 nights

Day One:

This morning, the group will depart by motorcoach for Toronto, ON! On arrival, the group will have dinner and then travel to the top of the **CN Tower** for a bird's eye view of the city. If you dare, walk across the glass floor and see the street directly below your feet.

Day Two:

This morning, the group head over to **Casa Loma**, the former Castle like home of Canadian financier Sir Henry Pellatt for a tour of the estate. The day continues with a visit to the **Hockey Hall of Fame Museum**, home of the Stanley Cup. After lunch, the group will tour the **Roger's Stadium**, home of the Toronto Blue Jays, and then end the afternoon at the **Ripley's Aquarium of Canada**. The day concludes with dinner and a tour to thrill even the most skeptic from **The Haunted Walk Toronto**.



Day Three:

Today, the group will depart for Niagara Falls. On arrival, the group will see the falls up close with **Journey Behind the Falls**, the **White Water Walk**, **Niagara's Fury 4D Film** and the **Hornblower Niagara Cruise**. Be sure to wear the included ponchos! The group will also have some free time along the banks of the falls or to explore Clifton Hill. In the evening, the group will return to Toronto via the Playdium where the group will have dinner and place the arcade style games.
