San Francisco Tour

3 days 2 nights

Day One:

The group will depart from the school early in the morning headed for San Francisco. Upon arrival, the group will visit the Exploratorium, an experimental, hands-on museum designed to spark curiosity. After lunch, the group will head to the USS Pampanito, a WWII submarine, for a guided tour. Later the group will explore San Francisco's past in the Dungeons of San Francisco. This morning, the group will explore the California Academy of Sciences, which brings together a natural history museum, an aquarium, a planetarium, and 4-story rainforest under one roof. Next, the group will enjoy a tour of the Boudin Bakery to see how they make San Francisco's famous sourdough bread. After the tour, the group will have a boxed lunch from the Boudin Bakery before heading home.
